STATE ROUTE 1 (PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY) AT CRYSTAL COVE SLOPE EROSION REPAIR

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be closing a short segment of northbound State Route 1 (Pacific Coast Highway) today near Crystal Cove.

The northbound No. 2 lane, located one-third of a mile south of the El Morro Elementary School traffic signal, will be closed for one-half of a mile from 9 am to 3 pm. so that crews can remove remaining embankment material as the resulting from an emergency repair. Motorists are advised slight delays could occur as northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to “*SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE*”, be alert, and proceed with caution.
