## STATE ROUTE 1 (PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY) REPAIR PROJECT AT CRYSTAL COVE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin the construction of two earth retaining walls on southbound State Route 1 (Pacific Coast Highway) at Crystal Cove State Park on January 10, 2011.

Due to stormwater runoff from multiple rainy seasons, the embankment has deteriorated. The retaining walls earth retaining structures will be built to protect and stabilize the existing damaged and eroded embankment. This will prevent the loss of the roadway shoulder and bicycle lane.

The roadway shoulder and bicycle lane will be closed for approximately two-tenths of a mile from El Morro Beach to Morro Ridge Road during construction, and bicyclists are advised to share the Number 2 southbound lane during this time. No other closures will be in effect and vehicle traffic will not be impacted. Work hours will be from 10 pm to 5 am, January 10 to January 15, and from 7 am to 3 pm beginning January 17, Monday through Friday. This project is expected to be completed by the spring of 2012.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to *“slow for the cone zone”*, be alert, and proceed with caution.
