EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 91 GRINDING/GROOVING PROJECT UNDERWAY

A California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) grinding and grooving construction project is underway to repair damaged concrete on State Route 91 (SR-91) in Anaheim.

The project work, which spans from the SR-55 to the SR-241 (Lakeview Boulevard to Weir Canyon Road) is being conducted Monday through Friday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. and on weekends from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Professional Construction Services is the project contractor. The project will be completed in mid-August.

The project consists of the grinding and grooving of existing concrete, the placing of asphalt concrete, and the installation of traffic loops and traffic striping.

This project is expected to remove damaged concrete along stretches of the freeway, and then replace it with fresh layers of concrete. This project also will perform grinding and grooving work to create a smoother ride and to create shorter stopping distance during emergency braking. The grooves will also help prevent hydroplaning and create more stability during rain.

Motorists are advised that night work and equipment involved could create some traffic delays during the overnight hours.

Lane reductions and detours are in place at this time, and every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to motorists, residents and businesses. For more information you may contact the District 12 Public Information Office at (949) 724-2000 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
