STATE ROUTE 91 FREEWAY WIDENING PROJECT FULL RAMPS, MAIN-LINE & SURFACE STREET CLOSURES WEEK OF JUNE 24, 2013

Anaheim—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue pavement operations on SR-91 at several On/Off ramps and Surface Streets. Alternate lane closures are scheduled late night through early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists. Consecutive ramps in the same direction of travel will not be closed.
