


CALTRANS MAINTENANCE PROJECT

STATE ROUTE 133 RESURFACING PROJECT IN LAGUNA BEACH

This Caltrans maintenance project covers a 4-mile stretch of the SR-133 (Laguna Canyon Road) from Forest Avenue to the SR-73/133 intersection in the City of Laguna Beach. This \$1.36 million maintenance project is expected to begin September 12, 2011 and be completed by early November 2011. All American Asphalt is the project contractor.

The project will consist of asphalt grinding and overlay. Work will be performed at night from 10 pm to 6 am and daytime from 9 am to 3 pm, no weekends. Residential and business areas within the 4 mile project may experience some noise. The project will include a temporary ramp closure at SR-73/133 both NB & SB. During that time a detour route will be in place. Caltrans will provide any necessary updates.



The purpose of this project is to repair the existing distressed pavement and preserve the pavement longevity. By completing this project Caltrans is providing a smoother surface that greatly enhances the ride quality along Laguna Canyon Road.
