STATE ROUTE 1 (PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY) AT BOLSA BAY EMERGENCY PAVEMENT REPAIR

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will commence preliminary work for emergency repair starting tomorrow, Thursday July 23, 2009, using the existing single northbound lane closure that is already in place. The work this week will consist of survey layout and sign placement. There will be no change in the existing lane closure from Thursday July 23 through Sunday July 26.

Starting at 6:00 AM, Monday July 27, 2009, the repair work will begin. At that time, the second northbound lane will be closed with through traffic in the northbound direction detoured off of PCH at Golden West, routed north to Warner Ave., and then west along Warner to return to PCH. The closure will remain in place until the repair work is completed, estimated to be August 7, 2009 at 5PM.

Local traffic, to reach the Seapoint Ave. intersection and the Bolsa Chica State Beach entrance (0.6 mi. south of the construction area) will be allowed on PCH north of Golden West.

Northbound bicycle traffic will only be allowed up to the Bolsa Chica State Beach entrance and detoured to the State Beach bike trail.

Southbound vehicle and bicycle traffic will not be impacted, with both SB lanes remaining open for the duration of the emergency repair.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to *“slow for the cone zone”*, be alert, and proceed with caution.
