STATE ROUTE 1 (PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY) LANE CLOSURE AT BOLSA BAY FOR EMERGENCY PAVEMENT REPAIR

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has closed the northbound #2 lane on State Route 1 (Pacific Coast Highway) one half mile south of Warner Avenue, in the city of Huntington Beach until the emergency repair project is completed.

This closure is necessary for Caltrans to install metal beam guard rail (MBGR) on the shoulder area. The emergency project consisted of Caltrans crews rebuilding the embankment by installing a steel-plated sea wall to fully support the shoulder pavement after experiencing a loss of asphalt due to erosion. Caltrans is currently awaiting approval from the California Coastal Commission for a permit to install the MBGR to complete the project.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to *“slow for the cone zone”*, be alert, and proceed with caution.
