Full Connector Closure of Northbound State Route 55 at Westbound State Route 91

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in partnership with Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) currently have an SR-91 Lane Extension and Auxiliary Lane Reconstruction project underway at the North SR-55 and Westbound SR-91 connector. Construction crews will remove existing pavement and re-stripe lanes for the next two weeks with nightly closures.

The nightly connector closure schedule is as follows:

Tues., Feb 18 – Wed., Feb 19	10:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.
Tues., Feb 25 – Wed., Feb 26	10:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.
Wed., Feb 26 – Thurs., Feb 27	10:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.

Detour:

North SR-55 exit West Lincoln Avenue to Tustin Ave or North Glassell Street onto West SR-91

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the closures. The project has 500 working days. The contractor is OHL USA Incorporated.

Once complete, motorists traveling northbound on SR-55 to the westbound SR-91 connector will have an option to exit Tustin Avenue using the new exit only bypass lane north of the connector, or the general purpose lane.
