




# State Route 39 | Beach Boulevard

## CALTRANS DISTRICT 12 / FACT SHEET COLD PLANE/ RUBBERIZED HOT MIX ASPHALT



### Project Description

Caltrans will be doing pavement rehabilitation on a stretch of State Route 39 also known as Beach Boulevard in each direction. The project limits are between Lincoln Avenue and Acacia Avenue, which will affect the cities of Anaheim, Stanton and Garden Grove.

Some grinding work will be necessary in this process and areas along/ near Beach Boulevard may experience some noise. Every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to residents and businesses.

The project contractor will be All American Asphalt. The project cost estimate is \$3.3 million. The start date will be August 6, 2012 with an anticipated completion date of late October 2012.

Upon completion of the project, motorists will enjoy a smoother roadway which greatly enhances the ride quality along State Route 39.

### Project Details

The purpose of the project is to overlay existing pavement with rubberized hot mix asphalt (RHMA) in both directions at post-mile 8.80/12.40. It also includes adjusting utility manholes, installing loop detectors and applying new pavement delineation.

The project calls for nighttime and/or daytime work. Night shifts are Sunday through Thursday from 10 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Day shifts are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Caltrans will provide any necessary updates to this schedule in advance.

### Planned Closures

The project will require lane closures of Beach Boulevard. Two lanes will remain open in each direction at all times. The closures will impact the local community commute, residences and businesses. We encourage motorists to allow extra time when passing through this area.

Changeable message signs alerting commuters of the construction activity will be posted. Motorists are asked to please be patient during this construction period.

**MOTORISTS DETOUR:** No detours required. However, motorists can use alternate routes: Western Avenue and Dale Avenue.

**ADDITIONAL INFO:** The timeframe of this project will cover one holiday (Labor Day). However, per Caltrans holiday restrictions, there will be no closure (work performed) for this project for the Labor Day holiday.
