Mechanically Stabilized Embankment Improvement Project on SR-73 Now Underway

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation has commenced an embankment improvement project to MSE Wall of the Northbound SR-73 just South of Cabot Road in the City of Laguna Niguel.

The project consists of 1000 feet of shear pile wall and earth anchors which will improve earth stabilization. The length of construction will be 300 working days.

Work is scheduled from 6a.m.-3:30p.m. with additional hours or shifts as required.

All efforts will be made to reduce the impact from the project but some noise may be evident from the required construction equipment.

The contractor is Ortiz Enterprises Incorporated of Irvine California with a construction bid of \$12,108,323.66
