

CALTRANS CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Week of April 23, 2012

SR-91 Mainline

WHAT: Compaction and paving of the roadway (lane addition) will continue to take place through the span of the project behind the K-rails. This work will be done throughout the day and night. Residents may experience noise and vibrations as a result of construction.

EB Lakeview Avenue Off-Ramp and EB Peralta Weigh Station to re-open to traffic Tuesday, April 24th!!

Intersection of Santa Ana Canyon Road and Lakeview Avenue

WHAT: One lane on both EB and WB Santa Ana Canyon Road will be closed periodically at the Lakeview Avenue intersection for crews to work on the median.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Daily, 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., Monday, April 23 rd – Friday, April 27 th .	One lane on both Eastbound and Westbound Santa Ana Canyon Road will be closed periodically at the Lakeview Avenue intersection.

Imperial Highway/Imperial Highway bridge

WHAT: Daytime lane reductions and nighttime lane closures at NB and/or SB Imperial Highway will occur intermittently. Residents may experience noise as a result of construction. Bridgework is expected to last until June 2012.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Daily, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Monday, April 23 rd – Friday, April 27 th .	One or two lanes on Northbound and/or Southbound Imperial Highway, between WB SR-91 off-ramp to EB SR-91 off-ramp.

WB SR-91 Imperial Highway Off-ramp – Lanes Reduced January 13th – May 24th

WHAT: Lanes are reduced on the WB SR-91 Imperial Highway off-ramp for ramp construction. Off-ramp will remain open during construction. Nighttime full ramp closures will occur. Detour signs will be in place.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
11:59 p.m. – 4:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 25 th and Thursday, April 27 th .	Nighttime full ramp closure of the WB 91 Imperial Highway off-ramp.

Weir Canyon Road/Weir Canyon bridge

WHAT: Daytime lane reductions and nighttime lane closures at NB and/or SB Weir Canyon Road will occur intermittently to erect girders for the bridge. Residents may experience noise as a result of construction. Bridge work is expected to last until June 2012.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Daily, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Monday, April 23 rd – Friday, April 27 th .	One lane on Northbound and/or Southbound Weir Canyon Road, between WB and EB Off-ramps.

EB SR-91 On-ramp from Northbound Weir Canyon Road

WHAT: EB SR-91 on-ramp from NB Weir Canyon Road will be closed at night to accommodate dirt movement.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Nightly, 11:59 p.m. – 4:00 a.m., Tuesday, April 24 th – Thursday, April 26 th .	Eastbound SR-91 on-ramp from Northbound Weir Canyon Road.

WB SR-91 Loop On-ramp from Northbound Weir Canyon Road

WHAT: WB SR-91 loop on-ramp from NB Weir Canyon Road will be closed at night. Detour signs will be in place.

11:59 p.m., Thursday, April 26 th – 4:00 a.m., Friday, April 27 th .	Westbound SR-91 loop on-ramp from Northbound Weir Canyon Road.
