SR-91 Nighttime Closures for the Week of October 10, 2011

EB/WB SR-91 from Imperial Highway to Weir Canyon Road

WHAT: Nighttime lane closure will occur eastbound and westbound from between Imperial Highway and Weir Canyon Road for crews to set gawk screen and paint and patch K rail.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Nightly, from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. Monday, October 10 th to Friday, October 14 th	Eastbound and Westbound State Route 91 from Imperial Highway and Weir Canyon Road, Lane #4.

EB/WB SR-91 Weir Canyon Road Off-ramps

WHAT: Nighttime full closure will occur for eastbound and westbound Weir Canyon Road off-ramps for lane striping and for crews to set K rail. Off-ramps will remain open at all other times and dates.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Nightly, from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. Monday, October 10 th to Friday, October 14 th	Eastbound and Westbound Off-ramps at Weir Canyon Road, Full ramp closure.

Weir Canyon Road between Northbound Weir Canyon on-ramp to WB SR-91 and Southbound Weir Canyon on-ramp to EB SR-91

WHAT: Nighttime lane closure will occur on Weir Canyon Road for bridge overhang demolition.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Nightly, from 11:59 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. Monday, October 10 th , to Friday, October 14 th .	Either Northbound or Southbound Weir Canyon Road will be closed. Detour signage will be provided.
