Closures for the Week of December 5, 2011

WB SR-91 at Imperial Highway

WHAT: Nighttime closure of WB SR-91 Express Lanes between SR-55 and SR-241 will occur. Crews will install piles for the gantry. Mainline SR-91 lanes and EB SR-91 Express lanes will not be affected.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
Nightly, 11:59 p.m. – 4:00 a.m., Monday, December 5 th to Friday, December 9 th .	Westbound SR-91 Express Lanes.

SR-91 at Imperial Highway (Imperial Highway bridge/undercrossing)

WHAT: Nighttime closure of NB and SB Imperial Highway will occur for bridge overhang demolition. Loop on-ramps to SR-91 will also be closed. Detour signs will be posted.

TIME AND DATE	CLOSURE LOCATION
11:59 p.m. – 4:00 a.m., Friday, December 9 th .	Northbound and Southbound Imperial Highway between La Palma Avenue and Santa Ana Canyon Road. Loop on-ramps to SR-91 will also be closed. Detour signs will be posted.

SR-91 at Weir Canyon Road (Weir Canyon bridge)

WHAT: Daytime pile driving will occur at Weir Canyon bridge from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. as part of establishing the foundation for bridge widening. SB Weir Canyon Road, Lane #1 will be closed during this time.

Residents and businesses are advised that the pile driving operation and the use of heavy construction equipment could be noisy and cause vibrations.

Daily, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Monday, December 5 th to Friday, December 9 th .	Southbound Weir Canyon Road, Lane #1, from Weir Canyon westbound SR-91 off-ramp to eastbound SR-91 off-ramp.
