State Route 91 Safety Project Week of May 13, 2013

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has an ongoing Safety Project to overlay all roadway lanes of the Westbound SR-91 from Harbor Boulevard Overcrossing to West of East Street Undercrossing in the cities of Anaheim and Fullerton. Alternate lane and ramp closures are scheduled late night through early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists. Consecutive ramps in the same direction of travel will not be closed.
