## CALTRANS CONSTRUCTION ALERT

### Nighttime Lane Closures WB SR-91 from SR-241 to Imperial Highway Week of September 19th, 2011

**WHAT:** Nighttime lane closures will occur westbound at various locations from SR-241 to Imperial Highway as crews set temporary "K" Rail barriers to separate the construction area from the live traffic flow. During this activity WB SR-91 will be reduced by various lanes, with traffic control. The Express Lanes will not be affected.

When completed, the current number of lanes will still be available.

10:00 pm Tuesday, September 20 <sup>th</sup> to 4:00am Tuesday, September 21 <sup>th</sup>	West Bound loop and straight onramps at Weir Canyon Road, and lanes #3 and #4 from Weir Canyon Road to Weigh Station to set K Rail.
10:00 pm Wednesday, September 21 <sup>th</sup> to 4:00am Thursday, September 22 <sup>nd</sup>	West Bound State Route 91 from Weigh Station to Imperial Highway, Lanes #3 and #4 to set K Rail.
10:00 pm Thursday, September 22 <sup>nd</sup> to 4:00am Friday, September 23 <sup>rd</sup>	West Bound State Route 91 from Weigh Station to Imperial Highway, Lanes #3 and #4 to set K Rail.
10:00 pm Friday, September 23 <sup>rd</sup> to 4:00am Saturday, September 24 <sup>th</sup>	West Bound State Route 91 from Weir Canyon Road to Imperial Hwy, various main lanes. Note: This is a contingency closure and may not be needed.
