## UPDATE!

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) closed the southbound Edinger Avenue on-ramp and the Dyer Road (west) off-ramp commencing 12:01 am on Monday, November 7, 2011. The Edinger onramp will open as scheduled on January 10th 2012.

**Due to pre-existing site conditions the Dyer Road (west) off-ramp will not open until February 10, 2012**

This full ramp closure is necessary to realign and reconstruct the ramp to accommodate the new auxiliary lane and bridge widening.


Detour signs and routes will also be in place to alert motorists. The suggested detour is as follows:

### Eastbound Edinger Avenue Traffic

Continue on Edinger Avenue to Redhill Avenue  
Turn right and travel to Southbound Redhill Avenue to Dyer Road  
Turn right on Dyer Road, turn left after Grand Avenue onto southbound SR-55 freeway entrance

### Westbound Edinger Avenue Traffic

Continue on Edinger Avenue to Grand Avenue  
Turn left on Grand Avenue to Dyer Road  
Turn right on Dyer Road and make a left onto the southbound SR-55 freeway entrance
