SR-74 (ORTEGA HIGHWAY) WILL BE CLOSED TEMPORARILY FOR ORANGEMAN HALF-DISTANCE TRIATHLON SEPTEMBER 25TH

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) advises that portions of the Ortega Highway (SR-74) will be closed at the following locations and times on Sunday September 25, 2011 for the Orangeman Half-Distance Triathlon:

- Avenida Siega to Antonio Pkwy [South lane(s) closed]: 7:30am – 12:15pm
- Antonio Parkway to Orange/Riverside County line at El Cariso (eastbound): 7:30am – 12:15pm
- Orange/Riverside County line at El Cariso to Antonio Pkwy (westbound): 7:00am – 12:15pm

Local access will be available to residents and Emergency Response Agencies who will already be in place for the event and be present on Ortega Highway (OC Fire Authority, CHP, CalFire).

This closure is pursuant to a provisional encroachment permit Caltrans has issued to Go Forward Racing, Inc. of Dana Point.
