
## State Route 91 Roadway Rehabilitation Project Week of September 24, 2012

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will grind, stripe and remove damaged concrete slabs from Interstate I-5, Buena Park to State Route 57, Anaheim. Alternate lane closures are schedule at night through early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists.
