STATE ROUTE 55 MAINTENANCE REPAIR PROJECT WITH DAYTIME LANE CLOSURES THURSDAY, MAY 31ST

Irvine - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) advises that daytime lane closures are planned 9:30am to 12:30pm on the southbound State Route (SR) 55 from Meats Avenue to Katella off-ramp in the City of Orange. This 3 hour lane closure on Thursday, May 31st is necessary to grind and overlay the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), #1 & #2 lanes.

The purpose of this project is to repair the existing distressed pavement and preserve the pavement longevity. Once complete, this project will provide a smoother surface that greatly enhances the ride quality along the SR-55.
