

Wall #6 FACT SHEET

WALL #6 NORTH SIDE OF SR-22 VALLEY VIEW TO SPRINGDALE

- WHAT** This is the first of seven soundwalls planned and designed by Caltrans District 12. A 16-foot soundwall will be built using split-faced concrete blocks with a total length of 1226 meters, which equal 4,022 feet long. Aesthetic treatments will include vine planting with some landscaping on the freeway side.
- WHERE** The wall will be located on the north side of SR-22 between Valley View Street off-ramp and Springdale Street overcrossing.
- FUNDING** The funding had been made available by the State as part of Governor Davis' Traffic Congestion Relief Program. This soundwall will cost \$2.8 million to construct.
- WHEN** The construction started July 12, 2001 and is expected to be complete by early 2002.
- WHY** To provide residents and schools noise attenuation for existing and future traffic on State Route 22.
- HOW** The Department of Transportation has awarded the contract to Macro Z Technology Company based in Santa Ana. Caltrans will oversee the construction to insure that it is built to our standards and specifications. Caltrans will also conduct a public outreach program to keep the residents and businesses informed of the construction activities within this project limits. For more information, please call the
