



I-5/ORTEGA HIGHWAY INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Sunday, April 19 - Saturday, April 25

I-5 / Ortega Highway Full Closures Scheduled for April 17, 18



Work on the north side of the new Ortega bridge is progressing. A concrete pour for the bottom and sides of the new bridge is scheduled for the night of April 24.

Full closures of I-5 in San Juan Capistrano and the Ortega Highway bridge are scheduled for tonight and Saturday night, April 17, 18. The freeway will be closed from 11:59 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the following morning. The Ortega Highway bridge will be closed from 11 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the following morning.


The closures are necessary to adjust the temporary framework for the new bridge on the north side of Ortega.

During the closures, motorists traveling north on I-5 will be diverted to the Ortega Highway off-ramp and will use Rancho Viejo Road and Junipero Serra to re-access the northbound I-5.

Motorists traveling south on I-5 will be diverted to the Ortega Highway off-ramp and back to southbound I-5 via the Ortega Highway on-ramp.

Motorists who want to drive into San Juan Capistrano from I-5 must use the Camino Capistrano or Junipero Serra exits.

Northbound I-5 / Ortega Highway Closure Scheduled for April 24



The Ortega Highway bridge and northbound I-5 are scheduled to be closed from 11:59 p.m. on Friday, April 24, to 6 a.m. on Saturday, April 25.

The loop on-ramp to northbound I-5 is scheduled to be closed from 11:59 p.m. on Friday, April 24, to 7 a.m. on Saturday, April 25.

The closures are necessary to allow crews to safely pour concrete for the sides and bottom of the new bridge.

Motorists must use Junipero Serra Road or Camino Capistrano/San Juan Creek Road as alternate routes between the west side and east side of San Juan Capistrano.

Motorists traveling north on I-5 will be diverted to the Ortega Highway off-ramp and will use Rancho Viejo Road and Junipero Serra to re-access the northbound I-5.



 - Sunday to Friday from 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Northbound I-5 off-ramp**
 - Sunday to Friday from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-5 Freeway & Ortega Highway Lane Reductions

- **Northbound I-5 between Camino Capistrano and Junipero Serra Road**
 - Sunday to Friday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Southbound I-5 between Junipero Serra Road and Camino Capistrano**
 - Sunday to Friday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Westbound Ortega Highway from Rancho Viejo Road to Del Obispo Street**
 - Sunday to Friday from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Eastbound Ortega Highway from Del Obispo Street to Rancho Viejo Road**
 - Sunday to Friday from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

NEIGHBORING PROJECTS

I-5 South County Improvement Project Avenida Pico to San Juan Creek Road

Construction is underway on the I-5 South County Improvement project. The 5.7-mile project will add a carpool lane in both directions on the I-5 freeway between Avenida Pico and San Juan Creek Road and reconstruct the interchange at Avenida Pico.

I-5 Ocean View Rehab Project

The Ocean View Rehab Project kicked off construction in October in San Diego County.

The \$37.3 million project will replace the damaged concrete pavement slabs of the slow lane in each direction of the I-5 freeway between Oceanside and the San Diego / Orange County Line.
