UPCOMING BRIDGE DEMOLITION

The north side of the Ortega Highway bridge over I-5 is scheduled for demolition beginning Friday, Dec. 12. The work is expected to take two nights, and the freeway will be closed during the demolition. Motorists on I-5 will be detoured around the demolition work using the Ortega Highway off- and on-ramps. The bridge will be closed to traffic and pedestrians during the demolition.

Ortega Highway Ramp Closures


- **Southbound I-5 on-ramp**
 - Closed
- **Southbound I-5 off-ramp**
 - Sunday to Thursday from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Northbound I-5 on-ramp**
 - Sunday to Thursday from 11: 59 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Northbound I-5 off-ramp**
 - Sunday to Thursday from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-5 Freeway & Ortega Highway Lane Reductions

- **Northbound I-5 between Camino Capistrano and Junipero Serra Road**
 - Sunday to Thursday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- **Southbound I-5 between Junipero Serra Road and Camino Capistrano**
 - Sunday to Thursday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

NEIGHBORING PROJECTS

I-5 South County Improvement Project Avenida Pico to San Juan Creek Road

Construction is underway on the I-5 South County Improvement project. The 5.7-mile project will add a carpool lane in both directions on the I-5 freeway between Avenida Pico and San Juan Creek Road.

I-5 Ocean View Rehab Project

The Ocean View Rehab Project kicked off construction in October in San Diego County. The \$37.3 million project will replace the damaged concrete pavement slabs of the slow lane in each direction of the I-5 freeway between Oceanside and the San Diego / Orange County Line.
