SOUTH WEED PROJECT ON INTERSTATE 5 TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK

REDDING – Caltrans District 2, along with contractor J.F. Shea Construction, will begin work on the Interstate 5 South Weed project in Siskiyou County on **May 3, 2016**.

Construction will take place from just north of Mt. Shasta to Central Weed. During the first phase of the project traffic on Interstate 5, from Truck Village to Central Weed, will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Ramp closures, with detours, will take place intermittently during this first phase. The majority of the work will take place Monday through Friday. 30 minute delays are possible during peak travel times.

This \$24 million project is a pavement rehabilitation project which consists of removing and replacing the existing asphalt, reconstructing guardrail, and placing overhead signs. It also includes drainage and electrical work. This entire project is expected to be completed by October 2017.

Please remind motorists to obey all instructions from the flaggers and to travel safely through construction zones.
