CITY OF SHASTA LAKE ADA BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT OPEN HOUSE

REDDING- The California Department of Transportation, Caltrans District 2, will hold a Public Open House on **Tuesday, December 1, 2015**, followed by a presentation to the City of Shasta Lake City Council regarding the City of Shasta Lake ADA Bike and Pedestrian Improvement Project Open House.

The project is located on State Route 151 in Shasta Lake City from the Railroad Underpass to Locust Avenue. Construction is expected to begin in the Spring of 2018 and be completed by late 2018. The purpose of this project is to:

- Remove barriers
- Construct new ADA compliant curb ramps, sidewalks and driveways
- Install bike lanes and other ADA compliant pedestrian facilities

Caltrans District 2 Project Manager Derek Willis will be on hand to answer any questions and address any concerns.
