



Navigating the I-5/Deschutes Road Roundabout



Rules for Driving a Roundabout

1) CHOOSE your lane before entering the roundabout. In advance of the roundabout, signs and pavement markings indicate which lanes may be used for the direction you want to go.

2) YIELD to circulating traffic, pedestrians, bicyclists, and large trucks. Wait for a safe gap in traffic before entering the roundabout. Circulating traffic has the right of way.

3) STAY in your lane. Never change lanes within the roundabout.

4) EXIT the roundabout by turning right onto your destination street.

5) SHARE the circulating lanes with bicyclists.

Drivers in the outside (right) lane are not allowed to turn left and must exit the roundabout.

Drivers in the inside (left) lane must turn left.

Drivers must yield to circulating vehicles.

Yield or Stop for pedestrians.
