FACT SHEET- FEBRUARY 2010

The Project

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin an operational improvement project at the Interstate 5, State Route 89 and I-5/South Mount Shasta Boulevard interchanges, south of the City of Mount Shasta. The project will consist of reconstruction or relocation of ramps and the construction of new connecting links to local routes.

The Need

The project will improve highway operations by reducing conflicts between northbound vehicles entering and exiting Interstate 5.

Jobs/Benefits

The project could potentially improve access to Mt. Shasta Blvd. at the southern city limits as well as improve operations of northbound Interstate 5.

Partnerships

This project is being developed through a partnership between the Siskiyou County Local Transportation Commission (LTC), the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

Project Status

Project study alternatives have been developed and presented to the Mt. Shasta City Council and the Siskiyou County LTC. Environmental Studies have begun on the identified alternatives.

Project Costs

The project alternatives have construction costs Between \$1 & \$5 million.

Project Schedule

Environmental study scheduled completion Oct 2011
