**State Highway 160 Three-Mile Slough Bridge Begins 24/7 One-Way Traffic Control**

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on a paint project for the Three-Mile Slough Bridge on Highway 160 near Rio Vista.



To ensure public and worker safety, one-way traffic control will be in effect. Crews will alternate lane closures in both north and southbound directions. This will allow one lane on the bridge to remain open during the work. Flaggers will help direct traffic. Motorists should expect delays and allow for extra travel time.

The Three Mile Slough Bridge or Bridge number 24-0121 will be painted over the next year to maintain and preserve one of the bridges that connects Sacramento County with Solano County in the delta region. The work will help prevent deterioration on the bridge steel structural members, and the mechanical components of the operating lift system. To avoid these delays motorists are urged to look for an alternative route or to use another mode of transportation.

The Three Mile Slough Bridge or Bridge number 24-0121 will be painted over the next year to maintain and preserve one of the bridges that connects Sacramento County with Solano County in the delta

Please drive cautiously and leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you. Caltrans appreciates your patience as we work to maintain California's bridges.
