Dear Mr. Earley:

Caltrans will be advertising a contract to correct a vertical profile 500 feet east and west of a railroad crossing. The railroad company installed a concrete slab at a higher elevation than the existing was and it is uncomfortable for drivers to drive over the slab. This project will smooth out the profile and make it more comfortable for the traveling public.

See the attached project plans title sheet for project location and the area of water use. Also attached is our water use estimate. The anticipated construction start and end date for the project are: 4/15/2017 and 5/1/2017 respectively (10 working days). Approximately 29,025 gallons of water will be required during construction.

Please let us know whether sufficient quantity of non-potable water is available for use within the construction limits of this project, what the cost and application process is, and the location where the contractor will be obtaining water
