RESCHEDULED CLOSURES

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Full Freeway Closures in San Mateo County on U.S. Route 101

Northbound US 101 closed from Third Avenue to Peninsula Avenue in San Mateo, CA

Southbound US 101 closed from Broadway Avenue to Poplar Avenue in Burlingame, CA

San Mateo – Early Tuesday morning on, May 12, 2009, through early Thursday morning, May 14, 2009, from 12:00 a.m. (**Midnight**) to 4:00 a.m. there will be a **FULL** freeway closure along northbound US Route 101 between Third Avenue and Peninsula Avenue in San Mateo.

All Southbound US 101 Lanes will be closed on early Friday morning, May 15, 2009, and early Saturday morning, May 16, 2009, from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 am.

These **FULL** freeway closures will allow contractors to continue the demolition of the Peninsula Avenue Overcrossing. **The work is anticipated to be noisy.**

DETOURS:

NORTHBOUND: Exit Third Avenue; Right turn onto Humboldt Street; Continue on Humboldt Street and make a right turn on Peninsula Avenue

SOUTHBOUND: Follow Peninsula Avenue to northbound US Route 101 exit southbound Broadway Avenue; Left turn onto Rollins Road; Continue on Rollins Road, which becomes Amphlett Road, to southbound US Route 101 from the Poplar On-ramp.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and encouraged to take alternate routes if necessary. Motorists are also advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.
