Full Northbound Freeway Closure and Pile Driving on Highway 101 in San Mateo

San Mateo – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled a full freeway closure on Highway 101 northbound on early Monday morning, July 30, 2007 from 12:00 a.m. until 5:00 a.m., and early Thursday morning, August 2, 2007 during the same hours to bring in and take out pile driving equipment needed in constructing the new Monte Diablo Pedestrian Overcrossing.

Pile driving in the center median of Highway 101 in San Mateo is scheduled on Monday, July 30th, 2007 from 6:00 a.m. until around noon. The operation will resume on Tuesday, July 31st, 2007, during the same hours, and, if necessary, may continue on Wednesday, August 1st, 2007, during the same hours, to complete the work.

This operation is part of the Highway 101 Auxiliary Lane Widening Project in San Mateo. The new Monte Diablo Pedestrian Overcrossing will be completed by Fall 2007.

This operation may be noisy.

Detour: 101 Northbound traffic will be directed off of the freeway at 3rd Street onto Humboldt Street and will reenter the freeway at Peninsula Avenue.

Detour will be clearly marked.
