### Peninsula Avenue On/Off-Ramps to close on U.S. Route 101

**San Mateo County** – On Monday evening, April 20, 2009, the on-ramp from Peninsula Avenue to Northbound 101 and the off-ramp from Northbound 101 to Peninsula Avenue in San Mateo County will be closed for demolition. After the demolition, work crews will rebuild newly-designed ramps at the same location. These ramps are scheduled to be completed and opened to traffic on May 04, 2009.

Detours will be in place while the on/off-ramps are constructed. This work is necessary to construct the New Peninsula Avenue Over-crossing as part of the 101 Auxiliary Lane Project.

#### **Detours:**

##### ***Northbound 101 to Peninsula Ave:***

Northbound 101 traffic will exit approximately ½ mile before the Peninsula Avenue exit at Dore Avenue. After exiting, motorists will turn left onto Bayshore Boulevard to the Peninsula Avenue Overcrossing and turn left at the intersection of Bayshore Boulevard and Peninsula Avenue. (see attached map) **The darker line on the maps represents the detour.**

##### ***Peninsula Avenue to Northbound 101:***

Traffic traveling to Northbound 101 from the west side of Peninsula Avenue will cross the Peninsula Avenue Overcrossing and turn left onto Airport Boulevard. After driving approximately 1½ miles on Airport Boulevard to the intersection of Anza and Airport Boulevard, motorists will turn left onto the Anza on-ramp to Northbound 101.


Motorists are advised to expect delays and encouraged to take alternate routes. Drivers are reminded that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.
