Overnight Closures in San Mateo County on U.S. Route 101

Menlo Park – Caltrans will begin demolishing the old Ringwood Avenue Bicycle/Pedestrian Overcrossing in Menlo Park on May 1st, 2012. To ensure safety for work crews and the public, **FULL** overnight freeway closures along southbound US Route 101 between Marsh Road to Willow Road in Menlo Park will be required. The new Ringwood/Pedestrian Overcrossing will be opened to the public on the morning of Monday, April 30th 2012.

All southbound US 101 lanes will be closed Tuesday morning, May 1st, 2012 from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 am. All northbound US 101 lanes will be closed between Willow Road to Marsh Road in Menlo Park Wednesday morning, May 2nd, 2012 from 1:00 a.m. to 4:00 am.

To prevent traffic congestion during the busy commute hours, this work will be performed overnight. This work will take a maximum of 3 nights with the first and second nights generating noise in the area.

Additional Closures:

Wednesday/Thursday, May 2nd, 2012, from 11:00pm. to 5:00am. Northbound and southbound lanes 1 and 2.

Thursday, Friday and Monday, May 3rd, 4th, 7th, 2012, from 8:00am. To 4:00pm. Van Buren Street (frontage road) will be closed.

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, May 8th, 9th, 10th, 2012, from 8:00am. To 4:00pm. Pierce Street (frontage road) will be closed.

DETOURS: Frontage road detours will be in place.

SOUTHBOUND: Traffic will be detoured to westbound Marsh Road to southbound Middlefield Road to eastbound Willow On-Ramp to southbound US 101.

NORTHBOUND: Traffic will be detoured to eastbound Willow Road to northbound State Route 84 to westbound Marsh Road On-Ramp to northbound US 101.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and encouraged to take alternate routes if necessary.
