## U.S. 101 / Tully Road Improvement Project Closures Scheduled

**Santa Clara County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will partner with the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) and the City of San Jose to replace the Tully Road over-crossing over U.S. 101 as well as reconfigure the U.S. 101 and Tully Road interchange. In addition, Caltrans will construct an additional lane on southbound U.S. 101 from south of Story Road to north of Capital Expressway and extend the south bound auxiliary lane from Tully Road to Capitol Expressway. The project will also widen northbound and southbound Tully Road / U.S. 101 off-ramps and install traffic signals at the terminus. Northbound and southbound on-ramps will also be widened and realigned with high occupancy vehicle (HOV) bypass lanes.

Construction activities will begin on Tuesday, November 23. Due to the upcoming Thanksgiving Holiday there will be no construction activities from Wednesday, November 24 through Sunday, November 28. See below for more closure information.
