Scheduled Overnight Detours

Caltrans will inform the public of scheduled overnight highway closures. For the latest information go to the Caltrans District 4 Website at www.dot.ca.gov/dist4.

Detour Route

When scheduled highway closures are in effect, motorists are advised to use the following detours:

- Eastbound Highway 12 motorists are advised to use southbound Highway 29 to eastbound Highway 37 to eastbound Interstate 80.
- Westbound Highway 12 motorists should use westbound Interstate 80 to westbound Highway 37 to northbound Highway 29. Local access is available for Jameson Canyon residents and emergency vehicles only.



Highway 12 – Jameson Canyon Widening Project



The Project

The Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Widening Project will widen Highway 12 from two to four lanes from Highway 12 and Highway 29 in Napa County to Red Top Road near Interstate 80 and Highway 12 in Solano County. The work will also add a concrete median along the nearly 6 mile project route.

Benefits

The project will also alleviate traffic delays, improve operations, and enhance safety by providing the two additional traffic lanes in both westbound and eastbound directions and a new concrete median reducing the possibility of cross-over collisions.

What To Expect

- Motorists are advised to expect some delays and plan for extra travel time. Caltrans will inform the public ahead of time regarding anticipated lane and highway closures.
- Changeable message signs (CMS) will be strategically stationed to provide information on lane closures and overnight detours.
- Local residents may need to show identification to Caltrans crews and/or law enforcement to access their property during scheduled overnight highway closures.

Project Schedule

The project is divided into two construction segments, a Napa County segment and a Solano County segment. Both segments are scheduled to start in the spring of 2012. The Napa segment is expected to be completed in 2013. The Solano County portion will be completed in 2015.

Partnering

The Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Widening Project is a joint venture between the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA).
