Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Overnight Lane Closures for Week of July 10th

Napa and Solano Counties – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) are starting related paving work and removing excavated soil in preparation of widening Highway 12 through Jameson Canyon in Napa and Solano Counties.

To ensure worker and public safety, alternating overnight lane closures will be in effect on Highway 12 between Highway 29 and the Napa/Solano County Line beginning Tuesday, July 10th at 10 p.m. and be completed on Saturday, July 14th at 5 a.m. The work is scheduled to start each night, Tuesday through Friday at 10 p.m. and conclude the following morning at 5 a.m.

Crews will alternate lane closures in both westbound and eastbound directions; this will allow one lane on the highway to remain open during the work. All work is weather permitting.

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will help direct motorists. Caltrans will also install changeable message signs. Motorists should expect delays and allow for extra travel time.
