UPDATE: SR-13/ASHBY AVENUE STREET RESURFACING START DATE CHANGED TO WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 1, 2012

ALAMEDA COUNTY – The new start-date for the resurfacing phase of the project along State Route (SR)-13/Ashby Avenue, from Hiller Drive west to San Pablo Avenue, is Wednesday, August 1, 2012, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily.

The first section of the phase, Area 1 – from Hiller Drive to Claremont, will begin Wednesday, Aug. 1 through Aug. 6.

Expect delays of up to 30 minutes at some intersections. **Posting of NO PARKING signs will be displayed in areas only where work is currently taking place.** Portable, changeable message signs will also be placed approaching the work zone to warn motorists of any expected or unanticipated delays along SR13/Ashby Avenue, prior to the beginning of the work.

It is the Department's desire and commitment to minimize potential disruptions and inconveniences during this time, while making safety our top priority. Caltrans will inform the public of all scheduled and unscheduled construction events and closures.
