


Alameda County State Route 13/Ashby Street Resurfacing FACT SHEET



Project Location:

The project is in Alameda County on State Route (SR)-13/Ashby Avenue. The improvements will mostly be within the City of Berkeley, from Hiller Drive to San Pablo Avenue. It is a two to four lane asphalt paved urban roadway with curb and gutters along the edge of pavement.

Project Purpose and Need:

The present pavement is in relatively aged condition; this project will dig out and replace sections of the existing pavement on Ashby Avenue with bonded wearing asphalt. This work will extend the pavement life and provide a smoother driving surface.

Project Cost:

\$1.4 Million

Project Description:

Located within the City of Berkeley, from Hiller Drive to San Pablo Avenue on Route 13, the project will dig out and replace sections of the existing roadway with bonded wearing asphalt, adjust monument and utility covers to finish grade, replace loop detectors and provide striping. One lane in each direction will be open to traffic at all times. Day work will be done Monday thru Friday, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Night time work may consist of dig out repairs at the intersections of Ashby Avenue/Telegraph and Ashby Avenue/Shattuck Avenue. Permanent striping for the project may also be done at night.
