

**SCL 17/ WET PAVEMENT CORRECTION PROJECT
FACTSHEET – May 2011**



Project Objective:

This project enhances safety along State Route 17 from 0.1 mile south of Summit Road to 1 mile south of Bear Creek Road over-crossing near the City of Los Gatos, in Santa Clara County. The major scope of work consists of constructing various drainage systems, and resurfacing the existing pavement. The concrete barriers and metal beam guard rail (MBGR) on the right side of the traveled ways will be reconstructed or replaced as appropriate.

Need and Benefits:

Upgrading drainage systems, reconstructing median barriers, and resurfacing pavement will eliminate the formation of concentrated storm runoff areas during wet weather conditions. Upon completion, this project will provide a more adequate facility for motorists.

Project Status:

The Design of the project was completed in September 2010. The project funds were allocated in November 2010 CTC vote and it was awarded in April 2011

Project Costs:

The Engineer's estimate for construction costs is: \$ 18,137,000

Project Schedule:

The project is expected to start in early June, 2011 and is scheduled to be completed by August 2012

Summary:

Upon completion, this project will help reduce traffic accident related to wet pavement conditions in rainy seasons in this segment of SR 17 in Los Gatos, Santa Clara County.
