Manzanita Park and Ride Improvement Project

Set to Begin

Mill Valley – Starting Monday, June 28, Caltrans will embark on a six-week improvement project for the Manzanita Park and Ride Lot on Shoreline Highway in Mill Valley.

The first task will start on Monday, when crews begin replacing the sidewalk along the southern edge of the parking lot. The new sidewalk will be more easily accessible for persons with disabilities. In addition, the pads, drinking fountain, and benches will also be replaced. This task will require Caltrans to close five parking spaces for a period of about one week.

On July 5, the existing bus stop will temporarily move from the north side of the lot to the south side for a period of about two weeks.

The northwest portion of the parking lot will close for three days sometime in mid-July. Caltrans will give plenty of advanced notification of the closure. Temporary Handicapped Parking spaces will be provided. Park and Ride patrons are encouraged to investigate other Park and Ride facilities in Marin County. A full list can be found on this web page:
