LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES CONTINUE FOR Interstate 680 Roadway Rehabilitation Project

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is rehabilitating Interstate 680 in Contra Costa County, from Alcosta Blvd in Dublin to Rudgear Road in Walnut Creek, and extending the southbound HOV lane from Livorna Road to .2 miles north of Rudgear Road.

To facilitate damaged concrete slab replacement, the contractor will be conducting lane and ramp closures throughout the project. Up to 3 lanes may be closed at night to facilitate work. Lane closures may begin as early as 7:00 p.m. and continue until 6:00 a.m. Monday through Thursday. Work hours on Friday and Saturday night may be longer.

Ramp Closures

The contractor will continue to work through the area, saw cutting and repairing concrete on northbound Interstate 680 from Alcosta Blvd. to Rudgear Road, and on southbound I-680 from Rudgear Rd. to Alcosta Blvd. When the contractor is working adjacent to a particular ramp, the ramp will be closed and traffic detoured. **This work is weather dependent.** No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Ramps may open prior to times listed.

Lane Closures

Tonight, on northbound I-680 from Alcosta Blvd. to Diablo Rd., Caltrans will begin re-striping and shifting the lanes toward the median. There will be various lane closures. At least one lane will remain open at all times. **Depending on the weather**, striping is expected to continue through Saturday night, then resume on Monday night. By shifting lanes, it will be possible to establish a work area behind K-rail on the far right lane and shoulder. Additional K-rail placement will begin tomorrow night, January 21, for northbound I-680.

Next week, beginning Tuesday night, January 25, the contractor is scheduled to restripe and shift lanes on southbound I-680, between Diablo Rd. and Alcosta Blvd. The contractor will begin placing K-rail on the right lane and shoulder on Friday, January 28.
