CRACK AND SEAT OPERATION TO BEGIN FOR Interstate 680 Roadway Rehabilitation Project

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is rehabilitating Interstate 680 in Contra Costa County. Next week Caltrans will begin crack and seat operations on northbound and southbound Interstate 680, between Diablo Road and La Gonda Way. Weather permitting, the contractor will work in the northbound direction Monday night, June 13, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., and work in the southbound direction on Tuesday night, June 14, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Paving for northbound I-680 is scheduled to begin Wednesday night, June 15, continue through Saturday night, June 18, and then resume on Monday night, June 20. In general, Caltrans will close up to three lanes between Diablo Road and La Gonda Way during this work.
