### **CRACK AND SEAT OPERATION CONTINUES, PAVING TO BEGIN FOR Interstate 680 Roadway Rehabilitation Project**

**CONTRA COSTA COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is rehabilitating Interstate 680 in Contra Costa County. Tonight, June 15, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Caltrans will continue crack and seat operations on southbound Interstate 680, between Diablo Road and La Gonda Way.

This work must be completed at night due to the multi-lane closures on Interstate 680. Caltrans will monitor for noise and vibration during this work. Motorists are advised to expect delays and allow extra time for their commute.

Paving for northbound I-680, between Diablo Road and La Gonda Way, is scheduled to begin Thursday night, June 16, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., continue Friday night, June 17, and then resume on Monday night, June 20. In general, Caltrans will close up to three lanes between Diablo Road and La Gonda Way during this work.

Crews are also working at many other locations for this project. Please drive cautiously through the construction zone and leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you. Caltrans appreciates your patience as we work to improve the highways. Please remember to “Slow for the Cone Zone.”
