INTERSTATE 680 ROADWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT Concrete Grinding Begins on Northbound I-680

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is rehabilitating Interstate 680 in Contra Costa County, from Alcosta Blvd in Dublin to Rudgear Road in Walnut Creek, and has extended the southbound HOV lane from Livorna Road to .2 miles north of Rudgear Road.

Concrete grinding between Alcosta Boulevard and Diablo Road began Tuesday night, November 15, and will continue for several weeks. Work started on northbound I-680 at Alcosta Boulevard and will continue to Diablo Road. Work will then proceed in the southbound direction from Diablo Road to Alcosta Boulevard. General work hours are Monday night through Thursday night, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., and Friday night from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. No work is scheduled from Wednesday, November 23 through Sunday November 27.

Note: the contractor is grinding the three right lanes, and can complete approximately one lane-mile per shift. Residents can expect that work will be near their homes for several nights.
