

Interstate 680

Ramp Metering Project

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) started the process to install 22 ramp metering elements and traffic operations systems, in Santa Clara County and Alameda County on Interstate 680 between U.S. 101 / 680 separation in San Jose and Scott Creek Road undercrossing in Alameda County. The project will be completed in 2014

The ramp metering work will be conducted in both the northbound and southbound directions in the cities of San Jose, Milpitas and Fremont. In addition, the project will also widen 20 ramp and install 21 off-ramp loops.

Construction hours are during the weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. There will be no evening activities and all work is beyond done behind K-rails to avoid impacts to traffic on the ramps. The construction activities on the ramps will consist of grubbing, clearing, excavating, paving and installing TOS (Traffic Operation Systems) or ramp meters. The ramp metering portion of the project will not be operational until summer 2014.
