Highway 12 Project Nears Completion; More Closures Planned

Solano County – Three more nights of closures have been scheduled by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) on State Route 12 (Jameson Canyon), as work on the Truck Climbing Lane project reaches advanced stages.

The lane closures scheduled from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. will be in effect on Wednesday, October 1; Thursday, October 2 and Friday, October 3.

The closures on SR-12 will mainly affect westbound traffic. The eastbound lane will remain open during this period, but some delays should be expected and motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes.

During the closures, crews will install underdrain for the project. Excavation work to enable widening of the roadway in the eastbound direction is also planned during this period.

Traffic heading for westbound SR-12 from Interstate-80 should detour by exiting on State Route 37 in Vallejo and then turning right onto State Route 29.

Construction on this project began in June, 2008 and is scheduled to be completed by mid-November.

No delays are anticipated during daytime work; which will be done behind temporary concrete barriers.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please “Slow For The Cone Zone.”
