Caltrans schedules more ramp closures on Interstate 680

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will on Monday, June 29 close two ramps that connect Interstate 680 and Interstate 80 in Solano County.

Beginning at midnight on June 29 and ending at 3 a.m. on Tuesday, June 30, the westbound I-80 on ramp to southbound I-680 in the Fairfield area will be closed. On the same night, a longer closure window is planned for the northbound I-680 connector ramp to westbound I-80 from 7 p.m. on June 29 till 7 a.m. on June 30.

The closures will enable the Caltrans contractor for the carpool lanes project to continue with the installation of permanent lane markers. The lane markers are being placed between the Cordelia Truck Scales and Green Valley Creek.

Changeable message signs and detour signs for the closed ramps will be in place to advise motorists during this period. Motorists can expect traffic delays during this operation and are advised to find alternate routes and use caution when traveling through the area. Please “Slow For The Cone Zone.”
