Night closures scheduled on Interstate 80

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct rolling lane closures eastbound and westbound on Interstate 80 from the Tennessee Street exit in Vallejo to the American Canyon Road Overcrossing next week.

Lane striping and guard-rail work will be done during the closures.

The closures will begin on Sunday, November 2 at 9 p.m. and end Monday at 6 a.m. Similar closures will be in effect from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. everyday through Friday, November 7.

The Tennessee Street to the American Canyon Road segment of the I-80 rehabilitation project in Solano County will be completed in November, 2008.

Separately, Caltrans plans to also implement various lane closures at night on the segment of I-80 between the Airbase Parkway exit in Fairfield and the Leisure Town Road exit in Vacaville. The closure of lanes as well as some on- and off-ramps will be from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will run from Monday, November 3 through early morning on Saturday, November 8.

The various lane closures, east and westbound, will enable crews to work on approach slabs and guard rails as well as complete paving of shoulders and on- and off-ramps.

This segment of the work on I-80 will be completed in August, 2009. Caltrans is rehabilitating 27 miles of pavement on I-80 from Tennessee Street in Vallejo to Leisure Town Road in Vacaville.

All closures planned for next week may be rescheduled depending on the weather.
