State Route 85 Resurfacing Project Begins

Santa Clara County—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on Monday, July 11 to grind and repave the roadway on State Route 85 (SR-85) from the SR-85 / U.S. 101 separation to Guadalupe River Bridge.

The project will only include the northbound lanes on SR-85 as well as 14 on and off-ramps within the project area.

Work being performed Monday through Thursday nights will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will end at 5:00 a.m. the following day. There are no freeway closures planned for Friday or Saturday nights at this time. Sunday work will typically begin at 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Monday morning. There will be various freeway lane and ramp closures during this project; however, **Caltrans will always provide at least one open lane in the northbound direction of travel and never close two consecutive ramps.** The project is expected to be completed by Fall, 2011.

Advance warning changeable message signs and detour signs are in place to assist motorists traveling in the area.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
