Interstate 880 Rehabilitation Project Work Begins

Santa Clara County—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on Monday, June 27 to resurface the existing pavement on Interstate 880 from Old Bayshore Highway overcrossing to State Route 280/880 interchange.

The project will include both northbound and southbound lanes on Interstate 880 as well as 20 on and off-ramps. In addition, new dikes, guard rails, crash cushions, concrete slabs and loop detectors will be replaced within the project area.

Work being performed Monday through Thursday nights will typically begin at 9:00 p.m. and will end at 6:00 a.m. the following day. Friday night work will typically start at 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Saturday night work begins 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday morning. Sunday night work begins 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday morning. There will be various freeway lane and ramp closures during this project; however, **Caltrans will always provide at least one open lane in both directions of travel and never close two consecutive ramps.** The project is expected to be completed by Fall, 2011.

Advance warning changeable message signs and detour signs are in place to assist motorists traveling in the area.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
