



California Department of Transportation CALTRANS PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

HIGHWAY 9 – SIGHT DISTANCE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Santa Clara County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to start a project along portions of Highway 9 near Saratoga, from 2.5 miles north of Highway 35 to 6th Street. The purpose of this work is to improve the sight distance for motorists and bicyclists traveling through the area. Work includes upgrading the existing lanes and shoulders, installing metal beam guardrail and installing traffic warning signs.

Construction will begin in April, 2014; however, there will be some preliminary activities such as surveying and vegetation clearing in advance of the primary construction activities that will start in March, 2014.

Construction signs will be in place to direct the public and bicyclists through the work area. Work will be conducted primarily during the daytime hours; however, some intermittent night work and weekend work is possible. One way traffic control will be in place starting the month of April, 2014.

The project is expected to be completed by fall, 2016.
